by Air

Via Kalaburagi Airport (GBI) – Closest Airport

- **Distance to HKE SAC Building:**
Approximately 16 to 18 km.
- **Travel Time:**
30 to 40 minutes by road.
- **Distance from HKE SAC Building to Gulbarga:**
26m (13.5 km)
- **Distance from Venue to Bidar:** 2h 41m (125 km)
- **Airlines & Routes:**
Kalaburagi Airport handles limited domestic arrivals/ departures, primarily operated via cities like Bengaluru.
- **Ground Transportation:**
From the airport, take a pre-paid local taxi, auto-rickshaw, or rideshare service directly to HKE SAC Building on Sedam Road.

by Rail

To reach HKE SAC Building from Kalaburagi Junction (KLBG) Railway Station:

- **Distance:**
3 to 4 km.
- **Travel time:**
10 to 15 minutes.
- **Route:**
Head toward Sedam Road (Mahadevappa Marg).
- **Transport:**
Take a 24/7 private/shared auto-rickshaw or a KSRTC city bus to the Government Hospital / Sedam Road stop.

by Road

To reach HKE SAC Building Campus by Road, your primary destination is Sedam Road in Kalaburagi.

Highway Routes from Major Cities

- **From Hyderabad (~220 km | 4.5 hours):** Take the NH 65 (Mumbai Highway) up to Humnabad, then turn onto NH 50 south directly into Kalaburagi.
- **From Bengaluru (~570 km | 10 hours):** Drive via NH 44 up to Anantapur, then transition through Guntakal and Raichur via state highways (SH 15 / SH 19) straight into Kalaburagi.
- **From Pune (~400 km | 8 hours):** Follow the NH 65 through Solapur, then switch to Akalkot Road / SH 182 crossing the Maharashtra-Karnataka border into the city.

Places to Visit

Gulbarga (officially known as Kalaburagi) is a culturally rich city in Karnataka that blends magnificent medieval architecture, spiritual heritage, and serene nature.



SHREE SHARANA BASAVESHWAR TEMPLE

Shree Sharanabasaveshwara Temple is a famous spiritual and pilgrimage center dedicated to Saint Sharanabasaveshwara. The temple is known for its peaceful atmosphere, beautiful architecture, and annual religious fair that attracts thousands of devotees from across Karnataka.

KHWAJA BANDA NAWAZ DARAGH

Khwaja Banda Nawaz Dargah is the tomb of the renowned Sufi saint Hazrat Khwaja Banda Nawaz. It is one of the most important Islamic pilgrimage sites in South India, known for its beautiful architecture and peaceful spiritual atmosphere. Thousands of devotees visit Dargah every year to seek blessings.



BUDDHA VIHAR

Buddha Vihar is a calm and peaceful Buddhist center located in Gulbarga. It features a large statue of Lord Buddha and beautifully maintained gardens. The place is ideal for meditation and relaxation away from city noise. It represents peace and spiritual harmony.

DEVAL GANAGAPUR

Deval Ganagapur is a famous pilgrimage town dedicated to Lord Dattatreya and is closely associated with Shri Narasimha Saraswati. The temple attracts thousands of devotees who come to seek blessings and participate in religious rituals.



MALKHED (MANYAKHETA)

Malkhed, historically known as *Manyakheta, was the illustrious capital of the **Rashtrakuta Empire* from the 9th to the 10th century CE and later served as the capital of the Western Chalukyas. Situated on the banks of the Kagina River in present-day Kalaburagi district.

CHADRALAMBA TEMPLE SANNATI

Chandralamba Temple (73.5 km via NH 150) is a traditional Hindu temple located in Chitapur, near Kalaburagi. It is dedicated to Goddess Chandralamba and is an important local pilgrimage site for devotees in the region.



Gulbarga



Gulbarga, officially known as Kalaburagi, is one of the oldest and most historically significant cities in Karnataka. The city's name is believed to have originated from the Persian words "Gul" (flower) and "Barga" (leaf), while the Kannada name Kalaburagi has ancient roots dating back centuries.

The region has been ruled by several prominent dynasties, including the Rashtrakutas, Western Chalukyas, Kalachuris, and the Yadavas of Devagiri, each contributing to its cultural and architectural heritage.

A defining chapter in Gulbarga's history began in 1347 CE, when Alauddin Hasan Bahman Shah established the Bahmani Sultanate and made Gulbarga its first capital. During this period, the city flourished as a major centre of administration, education, literature, art, and architecture. The magnificent Gulbarga Fort and the unique Jama Masjid, built within the fort complex, remain enduring symbols of this glorious era.

After the Bahmani rulers shifted their capital to Bidar in the 15th century, Gulbarga continued to prosper under the Deccan Sultanates, followed by the Mughal Empire, the Nizams of Hyderabad, and eventually became part of independent India after the integration of the Hyderabad State in 1948.

Today, Kalaburagi is an important educational, commercial, and cultural centre in North Karnataka. It is renowned for its historical monuments, the revered Khwaja Banda Nawaz Dargah, and its rich blend of Hindu, Islamic, and Kannada traditions. The city continues to preserve its remarkable legacy while embracing modern development, making it a destination where history and progress coexist.
